Since its inception seven years ago, the HENAAC Scholars Program has experienced unprecedented growth. This year alone, 78 students were awarded over \$190,000 in scholarships through the generous support of our outstanding scholarship partners. HENAAC SCHOLARS HENAAC Student Leadership Award:

One undergraduate and one graduate student will be selected to receive the HENAAC Student Leadership Award and scholarship. Although graduate, undergraduate and high school applicants will use the same application form, each group will be evaluated separately.

Basic Scholarship Requirements:

- Applicants must demonstrate leadership through academic achievements and campus/community activities
- Applicants must be Engineering, Math, Computer Science or Material Science Majors
- Applicants must have an overall grade point average of 3.0 or higher
- Recipients must be enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program for the Fall 2008 semester
- Applicants must be of Hispanic origin and/or must significantly participate in and promote organizations and activities in the Hispanic community

Each Scholarship Recipient Will Receive:

- A scholarship ranging in amounts from \$500 to \$5,000
- Listing and photo in the HENAAC Conference issue of TECHNICA Magazine
- Press Release on HENAAC website
- Complimentary registration and hotel accommodations to the HENAAC 2008 Career Conference and Awards Show. Qualifying students may also receive transportation support.
- Scholarship will be awarded at the **20th Annual HENAAC Conference in Houston, Texas on October 10, 11 &, 12, 2008**. Winners MUST attend the conference to receive the scholarship.

Application Must Include:

- Completed application form
- A 700 word essay describing the technological innovation on scientific discovery that has inspired you to pursue your engineering or science major. Please add how you will personally contribute to the world of innovation and discovery.
- Current resume
- One letter of recommendation from a peer in a campus or community organization
- One letter of recommendation from a college advisor, MEP Director, Dean or faculty member
- Official transcript with the official seal of your college or high school
